### **LESSON 2: The Historical Books – Life of Jesus**

**a. The Gospels:** Acts 1:1-3 gives reason for the Gospels – That is... To show the life and work of Jesus Christ.

The SYNOPTIC Gospels (First 3) – means 'see together' –common content

Q-Theory = Matthew, Luke taken from common texts (commonly believed to be Mark and Q).

#### b. The Gospels at a Glance

Matt Lion	Jesus as the righteous King of the Jews, the <b>Lion</b> of the Tribe of Judah. Emphasis on <b>right</b> - <b>eousness</b> . [Spoke 18, pg 323]
Mark Ox	Jesus as the Servant and the Workman of the Lord. Emphasis on His Miracles, Strength, and <b>Action</b> . [Spoke 19, pg 331]
Luke Man	Jesus as the Great Physician and Friend of Sinners. Empha- sis on His <b>Humanity</b> , Wisdom, and Mercy. [Spoke 20, pg 342]
John Eagle	Jesus as the Word of God, the Living Bread that "came down from heaven." Emphasis on His <b>Divinity</b> . [Spoke 21, pg 355]
