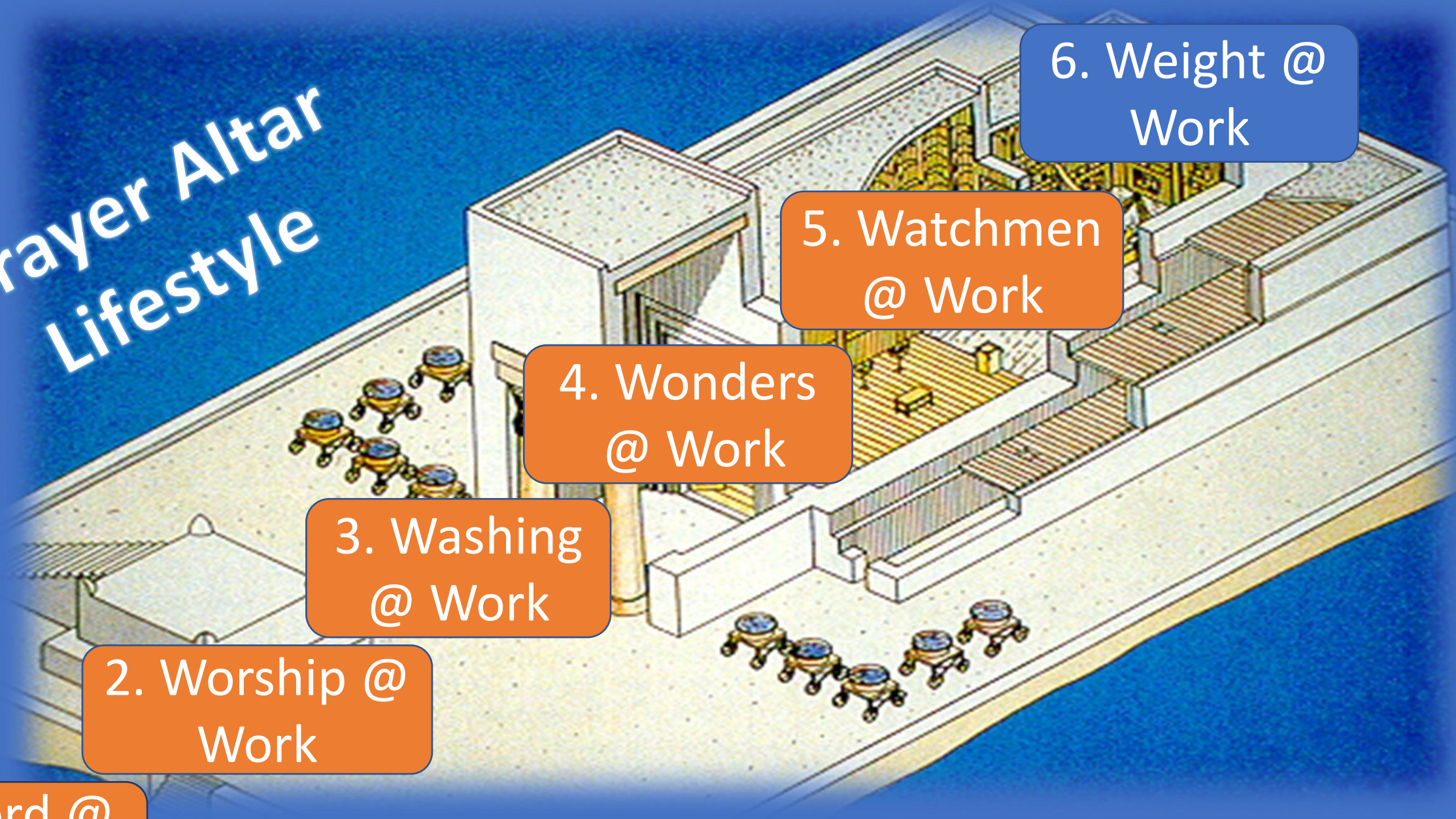

What is Intercession?

“So I sought for a man among them who would make a wall, and stand in the gap before Me on behalf of the land, that I should not destroy it; but I found no one.” Ezekiel 22:30



It is coming before God's throne on behalf of people in your workplace and pleading for Him to take away His wrath and bring salvation.

The Example of Jesus.

Jesus demonstrated what intercession is.

Isaiah 53:12 *Therefore I will give him a portion among the great, and he will divide the spoils with the strong, because he poured out his life unto death, and was numbered with the transgressors. For he bore the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.*

Identificational Replacement
– *putting yourself in their shoes.*

Identificational Realization –
seeing them through God's eyes.

Identificational Repentance –
repenting on their behalf.

Agony – bearing other's burdens

The 3 elements of Intercession.

1. Association (Nehemiah 1:7; Daniel 9:5)

“We have sinned”, not “they have sinned”.

2. Agony – bearing other’s burdens

(Galatians 6:2; Romans 8:26; Colossians 1:24)

3. Authority (John 12:24).
